## Prep School Art Scholarship

## Art Scholarship Requirements

Pupils should:

- Have a strong passion for art and a highly developed ability in the fundamental art skills: drawing and painting. Pupils who excel in other areas, such as sculpture, digital design, collage or printmaking are very welcome to apply.
- Have a good portfolio of work which demonstrates their skill. The work should not be from a previous school, but a collection of works the pupil has created independently, which shows their areas of interest.
- Be interested in art. A scholar should be able to express their preferences in art and refer to artists who inspire them.
- Be willing to be an active part of the art department, helping to curate exhibitions and events.

## Art Scholarship Assessment

The Art assessment is designed for potential scholars to demonstrate their creative talents in an informal environment. They should arrive ready to discuss their experiences and preferences in art and present their portfolio.

### **1. What will applicants be doing in each session?**

Applicants will be drawing and painting as well as discussing their portfolios.

### **2. What will applicants need to bring with them?**

Applicants will need to bring a portfolio of their previous work. This should be independent work and may include work done at art schools or private lessons. Sketchbooks from previous schools may be submitted but should not be the only work. Applicants may bring along any materials they particularly like working with, but this is not essential.

### **3. What will applicants need to prepare in advance?**

Applicants will need to prepare at least three A4 observational drawings of everyday objects from their homes.
